Dear Diabetes Day at the Capitol Participant,

We are excited you will be attending Diabetes Day at the Capitol on February 27, 2007! To help prepare you for the day, we have enclosed the agenda, the "Message" and the "Facts" for speaking to your legislator! This information will help you know what to say during your meetings.

If you have not had success in making an appointment with your legislator, it's not too late! Often times, an appointment is made at the last minute! So, continue trying and we'll help you that day if needed.

If you have friends or family that would like to come with you but haven't registered, no problem! Bring them along. We need as many people as possible to attend this event! Spread the Word!

Also, please wear appropriate attire that can easily be covered by a t-shirt (*the American Diabetes Association will provide t-shirts for us that day*). In addition, comfortable shoes will make your day a little more tolerable!

A parking garage is available that can be accessed next to the Capitol Annex 702 Capitol Avenue. Across to the Capitol Annex is via an underground tunnel. Signs will direct you.

The following directions are intended as a guide. Please compare these directions with your personal directions to the Capitol.

From the East: Exit I-64 at the second Frankfort exit ramp (U.S. 127 North) (53-B); proceed north on U.S. 127; turn right at the intersection of U.S. 60 (*Louisville Road*); drive ½ mile and turn onto Lafayette Drive (*Capitol Avenue*); at the bottom of the hill you will see the Capitol building on the left and the Capitol Annex on the right; proceed into the complex and follow the signs to the parking garage (*usually your best bet for parking*).

From the West (or Bluegrass Parkway): Exit I-64 at the second Frankfort exit ramp (U.S. 127 North) (Exit 53-B) proceed north on U.S. 127; turn right at the intersection of U.S. 60 (*Louisville Road*); drive ½ mile and turn onto Lafayette Drive (*Capitol Avenue*); at the bottom of the hill you will see the Capitol building on the left and the Capitol Annex on the right; proceed into the complex and follow the signs to the parking garage (*usually your best bet for parking*).
