Michigan Arthritis Data Collection

EnhanceFitness

- Manage data collection for all non-Y Affiliates (AAAs, community orgs, senior residences)
- Use the Sound Generations Online Data Entry System (ODES)

Self-Management Programs (CDSMP, DSMP, CPSMP, TCDSS)

- Manage data collection for almost all organizations offering Stanford programs in Michigan
- For data entry, use Teleform, an optical recognition software

Montana Arthritis Program: Data Collection

- What data is collected by the sites?
 - Demographic, pre/post, 6 month follow-up
- How is data reported by the sites?
 - Online portal developed by University of North Dakota, Energy & Environmental Research Center
- What does the MAP do with the data?
 - MAP owns the data, able to export data from portal

Missouri Arthritis Data Collection

1. State-wide data collection occurs through Missouri's regional infrastructure
2. Course paperwork is collected by the leaders from each class
3. Leader organizes paperwork and ensures all pieces are included and filled out
4. Leader mails/emails paperwork packets to regional centers regularly
5. Regional centers review/organize/conduct quality checks on all paperwork
6. Regional centers mail/email to Missouri Arthritis Program
7. Missouri Arthritis Program conducts centralized data entry into both Missouri's database and the NCOA database as well as prepares appropriate reports for national entities, funders, etc
