

Utah Cancer Control Program (UCCP)

Who We Are: UCCP is a federally funded program to screen eligible women for breast and cervical cancer using mammograms and pap tests. These services are free of charge to eligible women.

What We Offer:

- Clinical breast exams
- Mammograms
- Pap tests - frequency determined by the provider
- Diagnostic services for abnormal results (breast and cervical) and are offered regardless if screening happened through UCCP.

Note: Services must be completed within 60 days of clinical appointments/issued voucher. This includes any additional biopsies or diagnostic testing that is needed for the patient.

- Treatment referral to Medicaid or charity care for breast or cervical cancer and pre-cancerous conditions based on patient's qualifying criteria.

Who We Serve:

- Women between the ages of 40-64 for all eligible services
- Women 21-39 are eligible for a Pap test if they have never had one
- Women 65 years or older are eligible for mammograms and are not eligible for Medicare or not enrolled in Medicare Part B

Eligibility Requirements for Women:

- Moderate income at or below 250% Federal Poverty Level. *See Income Guidelines (updated yearly)*
- Uninsured or underinsured (deductible or co-payment). *Note: UCCP will be payer of last resort*
- Residing in the state of Utah
- Residing in a border town (i.e. Mesquite, Colorado City, etc.) with limited access to screening
- Transgender on a case by case basis (contact UCCP for guidance)
- *Note: Men are not eligible for screening but may be referred to Medicaid if diagnosed with breast cancer.*

How to Enroll:

- Clinic or patient can enroll by calling UCCP at 1-800-717-1811.
Note: Enrollment options vary depending on the clinic.
- Women can re-enroll annually, provided they continue to meet eligibility requirements.

Income Guidelines:

- Income eligibility determined by UCCP.
- Based on gross annual income
Note: verified by using pay stubs, bank statements, W-2s and/or other Medicaid guideline options
- If the client has no reportable income, a signed attestation form can be used in place of income verification (contact UCCP for guidance).
