Washington State BCCHP History

- **1991** - Program started as a two-year planning grant
- **1993** – Program began screening clients for breast & cervical cancer
- **2009** – Added colorectal cancer screening
- **2018** – WISEWOMAN Program began
- **2020** – Screening for colorectal cancer reduced (transitioned to Health Systems Improvement)

What does WA State BCCHP do?

- Promote and provide breast and cervical cancer screening and early detection.
- Provide Cardiovascular Screening, Risk Reduction and Lifestyle Support through WISEWOMAN programming.
- With Health Care Authority, enroll breast and cervical clients in the treatment program if cancer is found.
- Partner with health systems to implement evidence-based interventions to increase screening rates.

BCCHP Program Activities

Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening & Diagnostic Services

- Over the years, we've partnered with between 500 and 700 providers across the state

WISEWOMAN Cardiovascular Screening, Risk Reduction and Lifestyle Support

- 3 FQHC Health Systems
 - 5 clinics

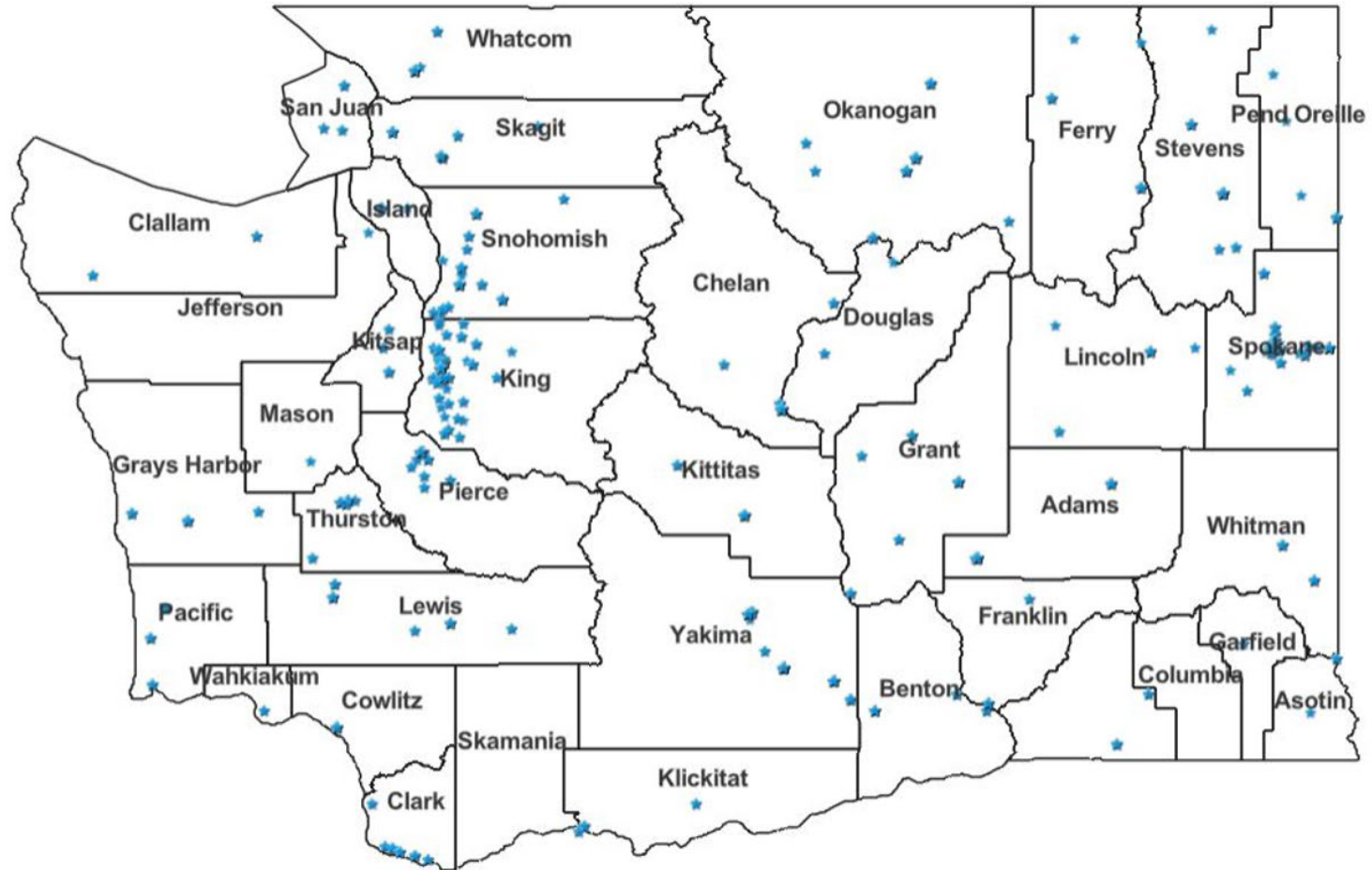
Populations Served

- Low-Income
 - Up to 250% of Federal Poverty Limit
- Uninsured or Underinsured
 - Program can cover cost of services or high deductible for insured clients
 - Reduce the barriers to care
- Limited Accessibility
 - Meeting populations where they are in the community
 - 500 + contracted clinics
 - Mobile services units (independently operated)
- Diversity – Racial/Ethnic, LGBTQ+, Rural, Tribal
 - Focus on ensuring that ALL Washingtonians have access to screening services and treatment options

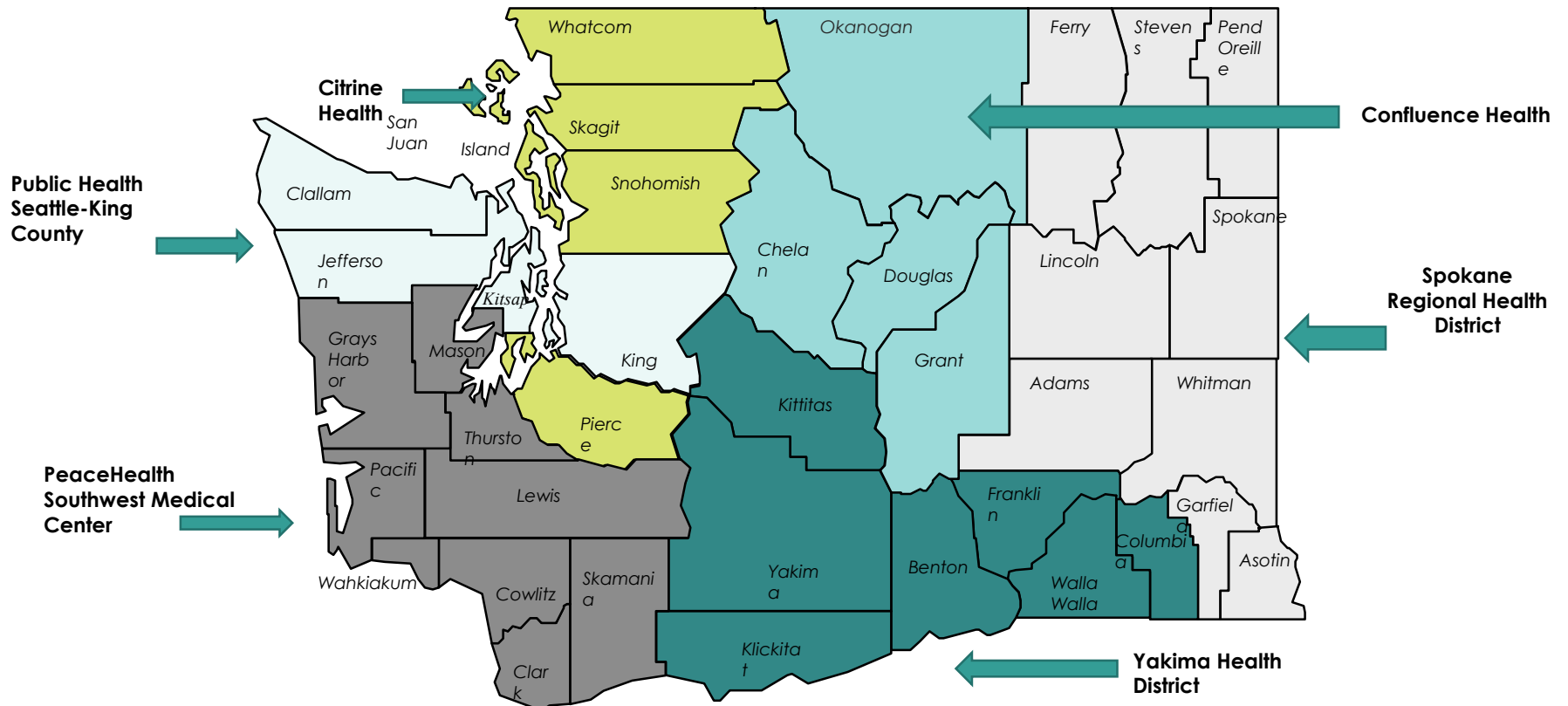
1993-2020 Program Activity

- **538** Current service locations
- **278,385** Clients seen for services
- **228,839** Total mammograms
- **186,668** Total Pap tests
- **26,796** Total HPV tests
- **162** Cervical cancers detected
- **2,996** Breast cancers detected
