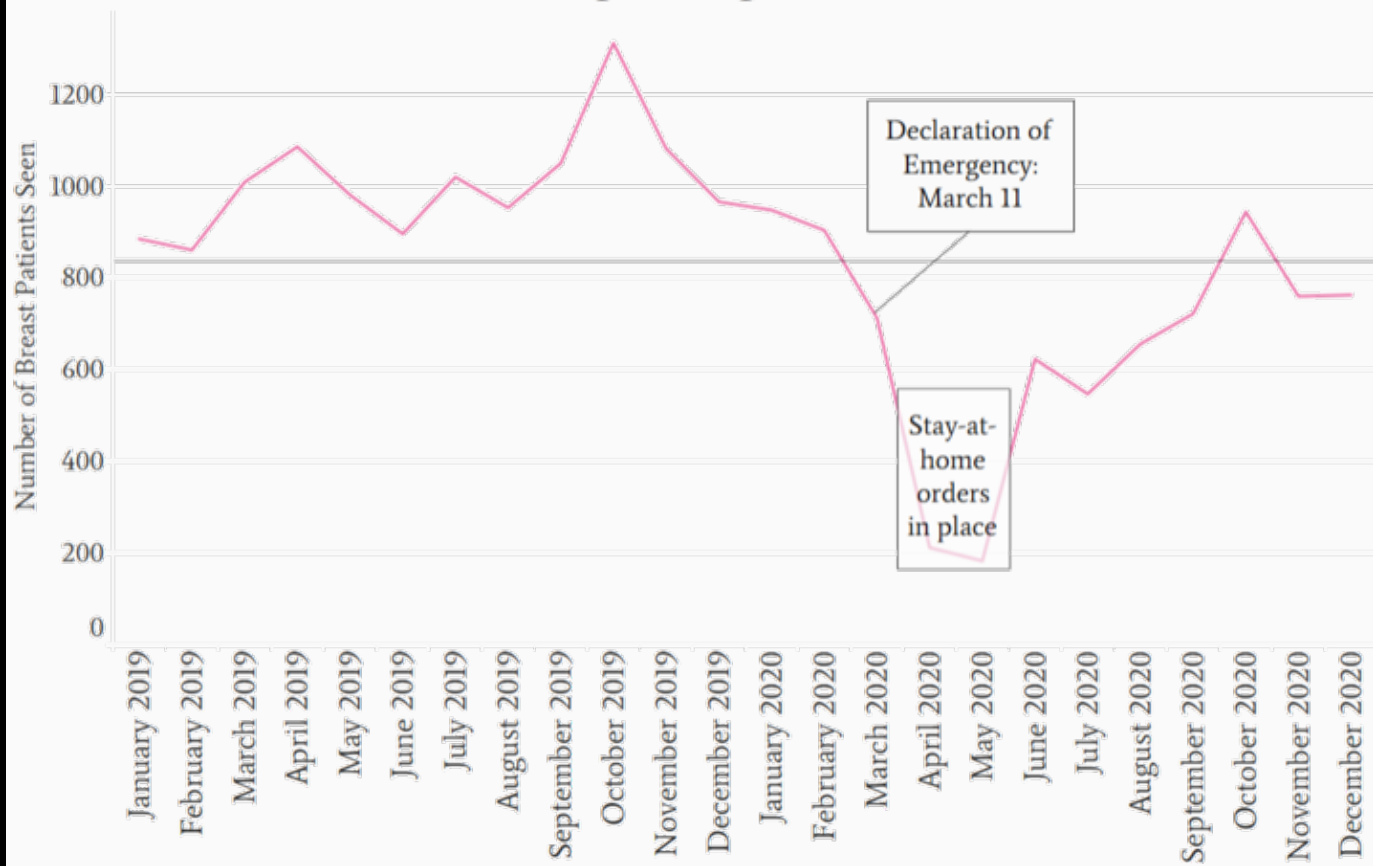

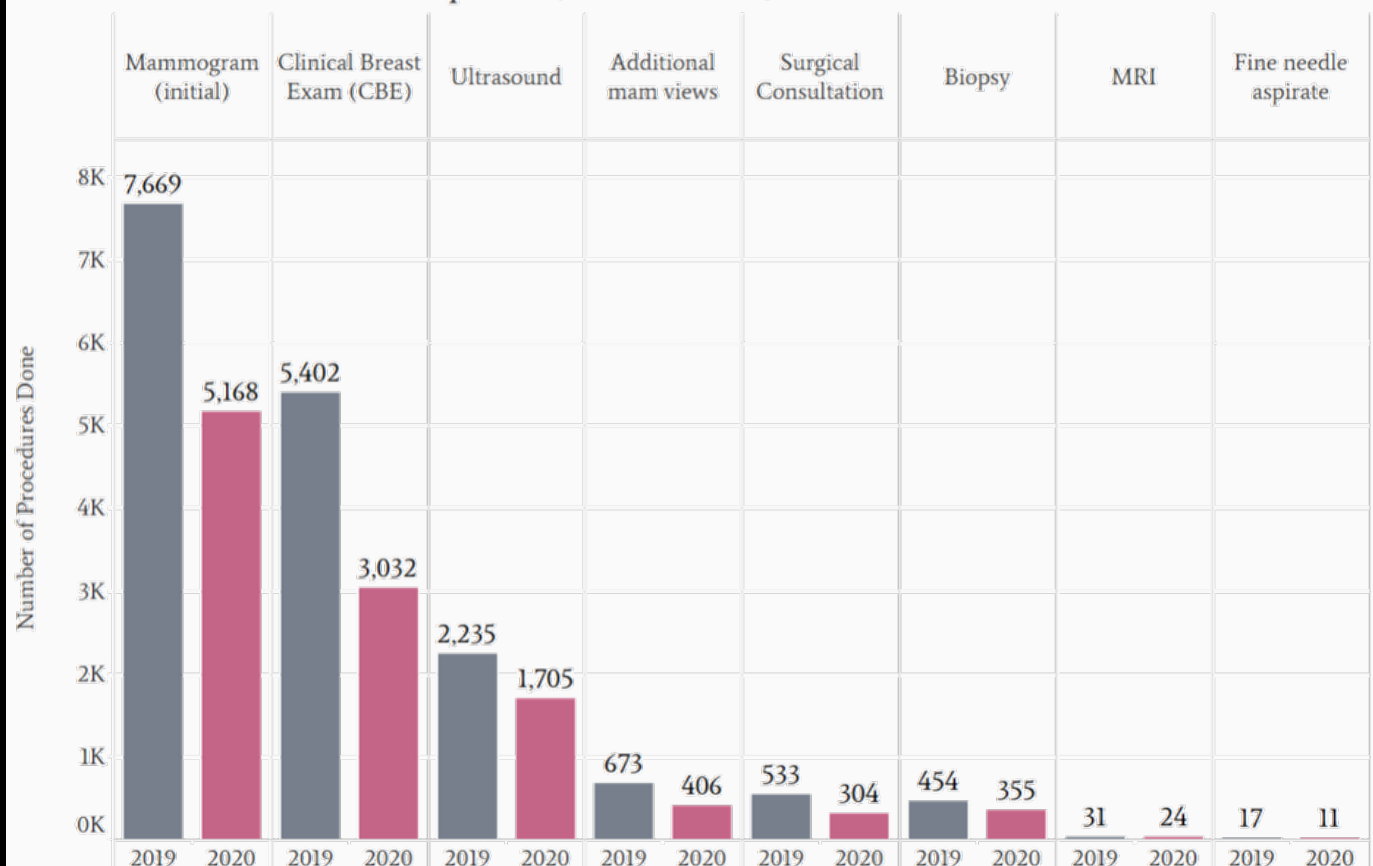
What was the impact of COVID-19 on how many women received breast services?
