

Georgia Breast and Cervical Cancer Program (BCCP) Direct Clinical Services and Minimum Data Elements (MDE) Data Collection

Goal:

The primary goal of BCCP's health system intervention strategies is to increase early detection of cancer and decrease cancer related morbidity and mortality among underserved populations through the provision of clinical screening services for breast and cervical cancer.

Eligibility for BCCP:

- Breast cancer: age 40-64 at or below 200% poverty and uninsured/underinsured
- Cervical cancer: age 21-64 at or below 200% poverty and uninsured/underinsured

Implementation:

- Develop goals for breast and cervical cancer screening services based on BCCP funding availability and health system capacity

MDE Collection and Submission:

- Individual data for participants served through BCCP will be collected using standard program data forms and submitted by the 7th of each month for the previous month
 - Demographic and screening history data (Form 3151)
 - Screening test results for breast cancer and/or cervical cancer (Form 3152)
 - Diagnostic procedures and treatment data for breast cancer when applicable (Form 3154B)
 - Diagnostic procedures and treatment data for cervical cancer if applicable (Form 3154C)

Health System's Commitments:

- Implement contract deliverables
 - Provide timely services in accordance with performance standards
 - Complete data forms according to BCCP Guidelines
 - Review data forms for completeness and accuracy before submission

BCCP Team's Commitments:

- Provide training and technical assistance on program requirements
- Monitor data submissions and provide feedback monthly
- Submit MDE data to the CDC biannually
