A Brief History

Serving the Underserved

- Uninsured and Underinsured
- Screenings and Diagnostics
 - Breast
 - Cervical
 - Colorectal
- Case management
- Treatment (through NYS Medicaid)

Ever Evolving

- Beginning: 28,000 clients
- 2007-08: High of 89,000 clients
- Declining eligibility since ACA passage in 2011
- Still averaging 25,000 clients annually
- COVID-19 pandemic: 8% of normal client volume in April 2020
 - Near full recovery as of June 2021

New York State Cancer Services Program Highlights: 1994-Present



Provided nearly **3 million services** to **700,000 CSP clients**



- **2 million breast cancer screenings**
- **680,000 cervical cancer screenings**
- **200,000 clients** provided with breast or cervical cancer diagnostics



Over **8,700 clients** enrolled into the Medicaid Cancer **Treatment** Program for Breast, Cervical, Colorectal and Prostate cancers
