Change in Average CRC Screening Rate (SR): Baseline vs. End of Year 01

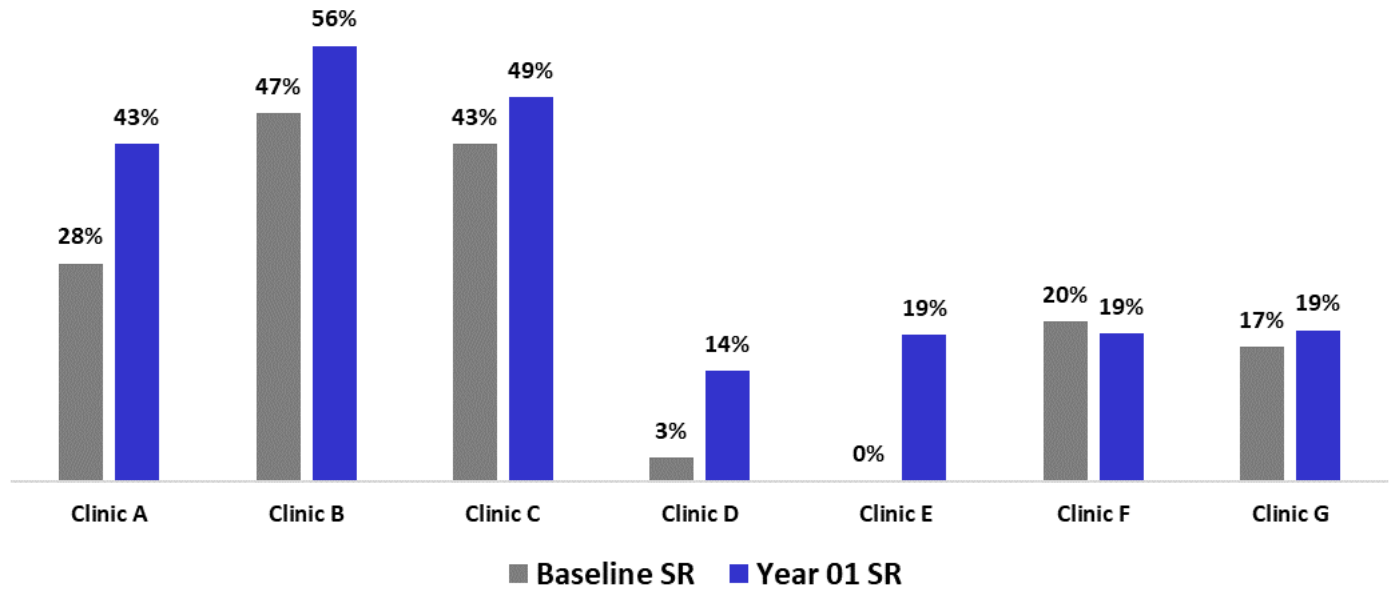


During the first year of the grant, MCRCCP observed an 8% increase in the average colorectal cancer (CRC) screening rate across 7 clinic partners



Change in Clinic-Level CRC Screening Rates

Colorectal Cancer Screening Rates:
Baseline vs. Year 01



During the first year of the grant, 5 out of 7 clinic partners observed an increase in their clinic-level CRC screening rate with the largest being a 19% increase.



Voices from the Field: Insights Learned

“Without accountability (standard workflow/audits and evaluation), staff will inadvertently cut corners and miss opportunities [for CRC screening]”

“Staff training is needed to ensure proper [EMR] document labeling. This will allow for more accurate reports”

“That with additional education to patients they are more willing to [complete]colorectal screening”
