Dr. Wiatrek, a Public Health Consultant and behavioral scientist, shared the Cancer Screening Change Packages, which were created by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the National Association of Chronic Disease Directors (NACDD), and the Cancer Prevention and Control Research Network (CPCRN). The change packages are quality improvement tools intended to support health care professionals in various clinical settings, and the community-based organizations and practitioners who partner with them.
