



Resource Exchange Summary May 15-18, 2023

The Cancer Peer-to-Peer (P2P) Learning Program offers a learning platform for NBCCEDP and CRCCP awardees to discuss programmatic innovations and challenges. During the May 2023 P2P call series, “**Resource Exchange – Tools to Accelerate Program Success**” awardees exchanged resources and tools related to the following topics:

- Public outreach to increase awareness of screening services, especially for those who are underserved, including the use of incentives and how materials have been adapted.
- Patient education to increase adherence to screening (e.g., how to complete a FIT) or conveying inclusivity of services, reminder materials.
- Use of data for monitoring and tracking of program progress (at the program and/or clinic level).
- Patient navigation, including the use of Community Health Workers.
- Provider training, including the use of electronic health records to increase screening/follow-up.

Awardees shared resources prior to the sessions. These resources have been collated.

NACDD and Strategic Health Concepts facilitated a total of four one-hour calls. The format of the calls included a brief presentation by either a NBCCEDP or CRCCP awardee sharing a resource related to the call topic, followed by a facilitated large group discussion, with additional resource sharing by participants. Those sharing resources were asked to answer:

- What is the resource? How was it developed and how are you using it?
- What have been the outcomes of using the resource?
- What advice would you give other programs if they would like to use the resource?
