 - BCCCP Coordinator attends NC PICCS TA calls with Kintegra -Statesville

Outcomes, Results, and Lessons Learned

- Kintegra Health History
 - BCCCP Contractor for many years
 - NC PICCS EBI projects for three years
 - Started discussions on a formal cervical EBI project with BCCCP
- Results and Lessons Learned
 - Kintegra is familiar with data requirements and collections, QI Processes, and timelines which creates a valuable partnership
 - Looking into other partners including those who have been a NC PICCS partner
