This national effort created partnerships between public and private organizations to offer evidence-based, cost-effective ways to help prevent type 2 diabetes. <u>Healm</u> is a free, online decision-support tool that guides employer benefit decision-makers as they make informed decisions about providing the National DPP lifestyle change program as a covered benefit for employees.

What is Healm?

Healm is a free online platform developed with and for employers to help you make informed decisions about providing the National Diabetes Prevention Program (National DPP) lifestyle change program as a covered benefit to your employees. Healm helps you design a type 2 diabetes prevention strategy in your workforce—thus reducing diabetes-related costs and helping improve health and wellness for your employees.

Healm includes proprietary decision-making software, a personalized progress tracking and metrics dashboard, and tailored support. These tools can help you get approval for the program from your organization's leadership and implement the program successfully as well as offer it as a covered benefit.

When you register and log in to Healm, you will have access to a wealth of information about the National DPP lifestyle change program. This information is presented in a variety of formats, including interactive learning modules and videos.

As you work through the content, you will be asked a series of questions about your organization, which will allow the system to customize your experience. Your answers will also populate a customizable dashboard that you can use to measure success after adopting the National DPP lifestyle change program. You can change this information as needed if you decide to cover the program for your workforce.
