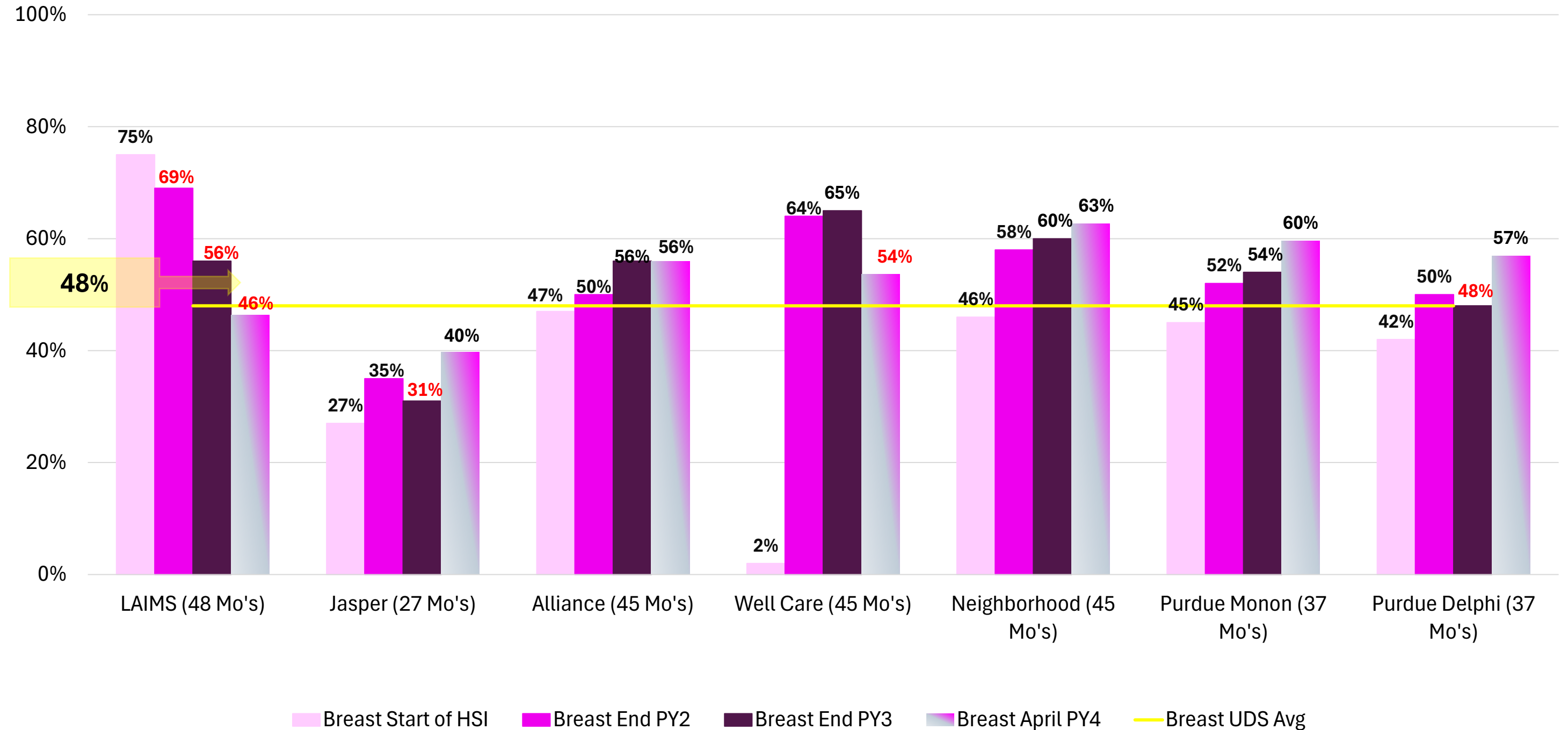

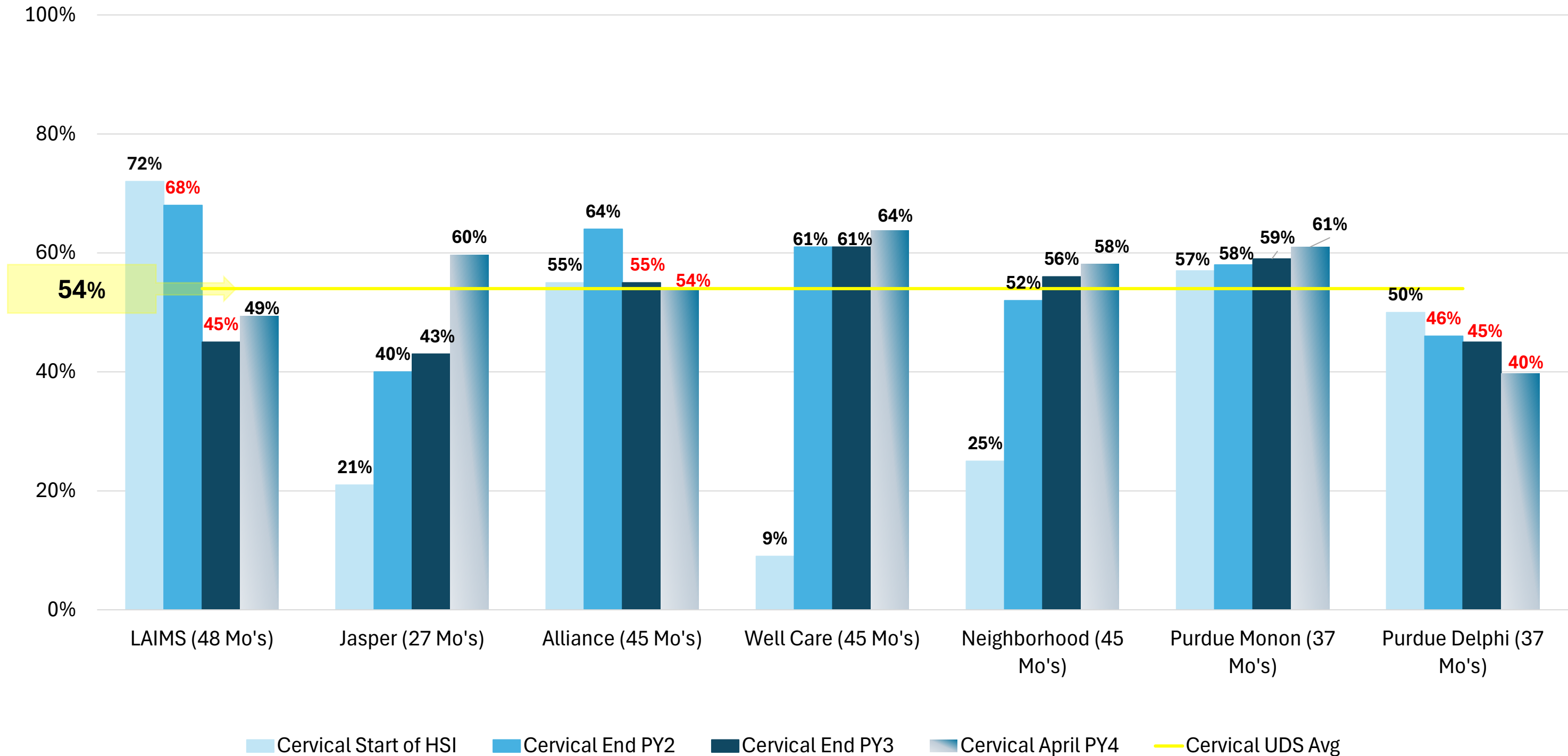


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HSI Breast Cancer Screening Rates at Baseline, PY2, PY3, and April PY4
